ISM Summer University in the Baltics



Why ISM Summer University courses in the Baltics?

The ISM Summer University in the Baltics will enable students to study during the best time of the year in one of the fastest changing regions of Europe:

- The ISM Summer University in the Baltics has already attracted more than 250 students coming from Europe, Asia, Australia and the USA since 2012.
- The ISM University of Management and Economics is the top ranked University in the Baltics founded by BI Norwegian Business School.
- Majority of the courses are taught by PhD qualified faculty with a strong international background.
- All courses include company visits.
- The ISM campus in Vilnius is located in a historic building in the Old Town, a former Basilian monastery.

Courses

The following courses* will be offered at the ISM Summer University in the Baltics 2017. Participants can apply for one or two courses (6 ECTS credits each). All courses will be taught in English:

- International project management

- Corporate finance

The programme also includes weekend trip to the Lithuanian seaside, local and multinational company visits, exciting cultural and social activities.
